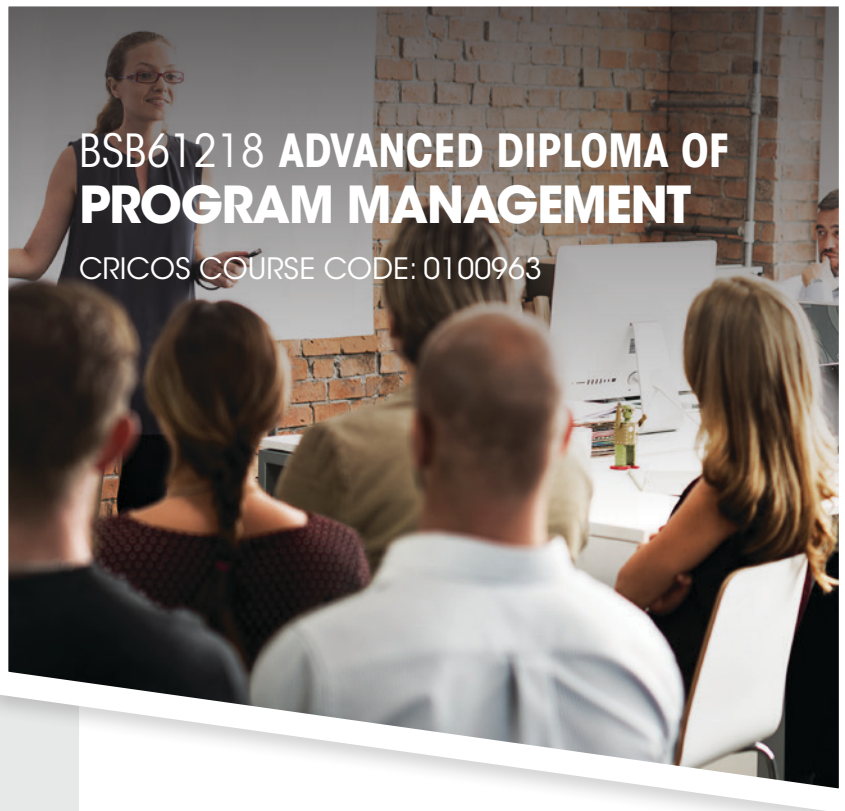


The students most likely to contribute to the cohort for this training is those people who are seeking to be employed in a role where they will apply specialised knowledge and skills, together with experience in program management across a range of enterprise and industry contexts.

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed in a role that they will apply project management techniques, skills and knowledge in a wide variety of contexts. Job titles for these roles are varied and growing.

It applies to individuals who are program managers, managing or directing a suite of projects (a program) to achieve organisational objectives.

Individuals at this level use initiative and judgement to direct, plan, and lead a range of program functions, with accountability for personal and team outcomes within broad parameters.



UNITS

There are 4 Core and 8 Elective units in this course totalling 12 units of study.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT (Training Package)

Entry to this qualification is limited to those who:

1. Have completed a Diploma of Project Management qualification; or
2. Have completed two years equivalent full-time relevant workplace experience at a significant level within a project or program environment within an enterprise.

ENTRY REQUIREMENT (International Students)

1. be a minimum of 18 years of age;
2. have completed Year 12 or equivalent;
3. Successfully completed the AIS pre-course review; and
4. have an IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent.

COURSE COST

1. \$9,000 Tuition fee plus;
2. \$200 Application fee;
3. Term fee is \$1,500.

Fees are paid prior to the commencement of each term by bank transfer or credit card. All prices are in \$AUD.

This includes:

1. BSB61218 Advanced Diploma of Program Management;
2. Training material, assessments; and
3. Practical activities.

DELIVERY MODE AND DURATION

1. **Time to complete:** Up to 80 weeks
2. **Terms:** 6 terms
3. **Each Term:** 10 weeks plus a 2 week study break (an extra 2-4 weeks over the Christmas period)
4. **Delivery:** Classroom
5. **Days:** 2 days per week as a Lecture class, each day is 8 hours with breaks plus; ½ day per week as a Tutorial class at 5 hours with breaks
6. **Self-paced learning:** 4.75 hours per week
7. **Total time:** 1,235 hours
