HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage therapy:

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed in a role whereby they will be engaged as massage therapists who provide general health maintenance treatments. It does not reflect the role of a remedial massage therapist. Practitioners may be self-employed or work within a larger health service.

Students must complete HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage therapy to progress to HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial massage.

HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial massage

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed in the role of remedial massage therapists who work with clients presenting with soft tissue dysfunction, musculoskeletal imbalance or restrictions in range of motion (ROM). Practitioners may be self-employed or work within a larger health service.

At the end on completing each course a Certificate will be issued and used as the evidence, where appropriate, to apply for Credit Transfer in the next qualification.
