SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy; and  
SHB50115 Diploma of Beauty Therapy

### PACKAGED COURSES FOR BEAUTY SERVICES

Australasia International School (AIS) combines courses under the same training package for those students who are seeking to obtain further and in depth industry knowledge and skills.

AIS has professionally set up beauty training rooms and has highly skilled trainers to facilitate these courses so that students can learn, be confident and be ready for industry upon successful completion of their studies.

#### **SHB30115 Certificate III in Beauty Services:**

This course provides the skills to be employed as a beautician that provides a range of beauty services including waxing, lash and brow, make-up and manicure and pedicure services in the beauty industry.

These individuals possess a range of well-developed technical and customer service skills where discretion and judgement are required and are responsible for their own outputs. This includes client consultation on beauty products and services. Work is typically conducted in beauty, waxing, brow and nail salons.

#### **SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy**

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed in a role whereby they will provide skin analyses, facial therapies, skin-care treatments and body treatments such as massage to clients.

These individuals possess a range of well-developed technical and customer service skills where discretion and judgement are required and are responsible for their own outputs. This includes client consultation on beauty products and services. Work is typically conducted in beauty, waxing, brow and nail salons.

#### **SHB50115 Diploma of Beauty Therapy**

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed as beauty therapists to provide a broad range of beauty therapy treatments and services including facial treatments, body massage and treatments, hair removal, lash and brow treatments, nail and make-up services. This includes consultation with clients to provide beauty advice, recommend beauty treatments and services, and sell retail skin-care and cosmetic products.

These individuals work relatively autonomously and are accountable for personal outputs. Their work involves the self-directed application of knowledge and skills with substantial depth in some areas where judgement is required in planning and selecting appropriate equipment, services and techniques. Work is typically conducted in beauty salons and spas.

At the end on completing each course a Certificate will be issued and used as the evidence, where appropriate, to apply for Credit Transfer in the next qualification.

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to this qualification at the time of publication.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will be able to obtain a range of employment opportunities in areas such as Beauty Therapist, Skincare Specialist, Nail Technician and more. Graduates at this level will apply knowledge and skills to demonstrate autonomy, judgement and defined responsibility. Students at this level will have broad factual, technical and some theoretical knowledge of a specific area or a broad field of work and learning.

### PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites associated with the qualifications in this pathway. Individuals may enter SHB30115 Certificate III in Beauty Services with limited or no vocational experience and without a lower level qualification.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Domestic Students must:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent; and
- successfully completed the AIS pre-course review.

International Students must:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent;
- successfully completed the AIS pre-course review; and
- have an IELTS of 5.5 or equivalent score.

### RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) may be obtained for skills and knowledge obtained through previous study or relevant experience obtained in Australia. AIS recognises qualifications from other Australian providers and offers student Credit Transfer.

### AWARD QUALIFICATION AND OUTCOME

On successful completion of these courses, students will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification:  
SHB30115 Certificate III in Beauty Services;  
SHB40115 Certificate IV in Beauty Therapy and  
SHB50115 Diploma of Beauty Therapy.
