HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage.

### PACKAGED COURSES FOR MASSAGE THERAPIES

Australasia International School (AIS) combines courses under the same training package for those students who are seeking to obtain further and in-depth industry knowledge and skills.

AIS has professionally set up massage training rooms and has highly skilled trainers to facilitate these courses so that students can learn, be confident and be ready for industry upon successful completion of their studies.

#### HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage Therapy:

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed in a role whereby they will be engaged as massage therapists who provide general health maintenance treatments. It does not reflect the role of a remedial massage therapist. Practitioners may be self-employed or work within a larger health service.

Students must complete HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage Therapy to progress to HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage.

#### HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage

This course suits students who are seeking to be employed in the role of remedial massage therapists who work with clients presenting with soft tissue dysfunction, musculoskeletal imbalance or restrictions in range of motion (ROM). Practitioners may be self-employed or work within a larger health service.

At the end on completing each course a Certificate will be issued and used as the evidence, where appropriate, to apply for Credit Transfer in the next qualification.

### LICENCING REQUIREMENT

No occupational licensing, certification or specific legislative requirements apply to these qualifications at the time of publication.

### CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Graduates will be able to obtain a range of employment opportunities in areas such as day spa, cruise ships, work from home, mobile massage therapist; and sports therapy and health clinics. Practitioners may be self-employed or work within a larger health service.

### THIRD PARTIES

AIS has a range of agreements with Third Party Organisations providing recruitment services.

### PREREQUISITES

There are no prerequisites associated with this qualification. Individuals may enter HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage Therapy with limited or no vocational experience and without a lower level qualification.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENT

Domestic Students must:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent; and
- successfully completed the AIS pre-course review.

International Students must:

- be a minimum of 18 years of age;
- have completed Year 12 or equivalent;
- successfully completed the AIS pre-course review; and
- have an IELTS of 5.5 or equivalent score.

## RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING AND CREDIT TRANSFER

Recognition of prior learning (RPL) may be obtained for skills and knowledge obtained through previous study or relevant experience obtained in Australia. AIS recognises qualifications from other Australian providers and offers student Credit Transfer.

## AWARD QUALIFICATION AND OUTCOME

On successful completion of these courses, students will be awarded a nationally recognised qualification:

HLT42015 Certificate IV in Massage Therapy; and

HLT52015 Diploma of Remedial Massage.

## COURSE CONTENT

The Certificate IV in Massage Therapy requires the completion of 13 units of competency including 10 core units and 3 electives.
