UNITS AND COMPLETION

There are three units of competency that applies to this course. At the end of this course a successful student will be awarded a nationally recognised statement of attainment for the unit of competencies:

- HLTAID003 Provide first aid
- HLTAID002 Provide basic emergency life support
- HLTAID001 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation

COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENT

- be a minimum of 18 years of age,
- successfully complete the pre-reading and satisfactory pass the multiple-choice theory assessment,
- this course will require you to kneel and perform emergency treatments on the floor.

COURSE COST - \$150

Fees are paid prior to the commencement by bank transfer or credit card. This includes:

- 1 Training and training materials, assessments; and practical activities,
- 2 Wallet card.
