Australasia International School (AIS) is informing all students that the Sydney CBD campus will close down and all training and assessing will be conducted off-campus via Zoom for the foreseeable future.

What does this mean?

The recent serious events that constitute a Critical Incident and the government's information about the current situation in Sydney's CBD, it has been decided that we must close the AIS campus.

What is happening to my course?

If you are a BSB (Business student) or Diploma of Salon Management student, all training will be conducted through Zoom. You will receive further information about this shortly. If you are a massage or beauty student, all theory will be conducted through Zoom, some practical components can be assessed through Zoom (e.g. group presentations) and other practical's will be communicated from your trainer.

What is happening now?

Zoom timetabling is being prepared to minimise disruption and your current classes will be maintained where possible.

Zoom access information will be forwarded to you from your trainer.

What do I have to do now?

To maintain your current Visa, you still have to attend your allocated 20 hours of training per week. To do this, you should now be setting up an area for you to study and participate in Zoom sessions. Check your Wi-Fi reception, data allowance and have a comfortable place to sit.
